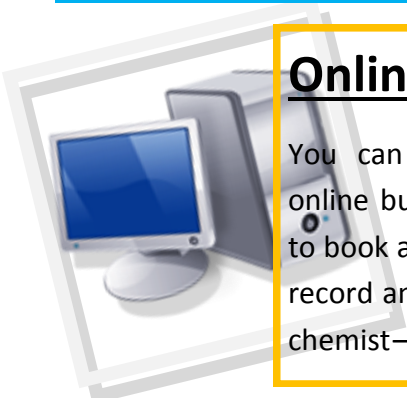
Online Access

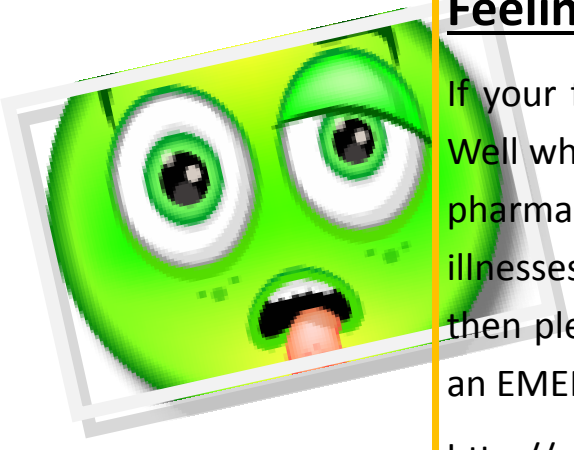
